

4x4 tour - procedures

1. The speed of the vehicles may not exceed 40 km/h, except in case of an emergency.
2. The drivers must keep the vehicle behind in mind and at junctions or when turning off, ensure that they wait for the following vehicle.
3. During stops, please stay close to the trail guide and do not wander off.
4. Smokers are reminded that cigarette butts must be taken along and not discarded in the bush.
5. The ash must be discarded in designated bin at overnights spots.
6. Refuse should be taken along and discarded at the rest camp.
7. No food may be discarded in the bush.
8. Remember toilet paper and a spade for "toilet" purposes.
9. The toilets at overnight spots must be kept clean at all times.
10. Any problems with the toilets must be reported to the trail guide immediately.
11. Please use sanitary disposal bags for sanitary products and discard it at the rest camp.
12. Sleeping around the fire is not permitted.
13. Driving must be responsible and spinning of wheels must be avoided.
14. Vehicles should be driven in four-wheel drive.
15. The guide will indicate when participants may alight from vehicles for meals or interpretation and this must be done in an orderly manner to ensure control and safety.
16. Sleeping in the bush is not allowed.
17. During the tour all other standard Kruger National Park and reserve rules and regulations apply.
18. Participants must abide by the instructions and requests of the trail guide, and non-compliance could lead to the cancellation of the trail.
19. The Greater Kruger National Park is located in a Malaria area. Malaria prophylactics are essential. Consult your doctor or chemist.
- 20. For safety and ethical reasons, consumption of alcohol is strongly discouraged on the trail. Consumption of alcohol while driving the trail will result in the trail being cancelled with no refunds.**



4x4 tour - terms and conditions

1. General

- ◇ Availability of the tour is dependent on availability of accommodation at the rest camp as well as the trail itself.
- ◇ A minimum of three vehicles is required for the tour to take place.
- ◇ A maximum of 20 adults (4 adults per vehicle) may participate per trail.
- ◇ No children under the age of 12 will be allowed.
- ◇ The trail is in nature and the guide may change the route or the schedule for the day.

2. Off-road trailers and caravans

- ◇ The total length of the off-road trailer/caravan may not exceed 4,2m. The smaller the better.

3. Tyres

- ◇ Only off-road all terrain tyres; no on-road tyres. Only tyres with a sidewall profile of 65 and more. Trails are very rocky and incorrect tyres increase the risk of tyre damage. The areas are very remote and it is not easy to obtain tyres when damaged.

4. Payment

- ◇ Refer to our payment conditions.

5. Cancellation of the tour by you

- ◇ Refer to our cancellation conditions.

6. Cancellation of the tour by the National Park or Nature Reserve Management

- ◇ Refer to our cancellation conditions.

7. Indemnity

- ◇ You will be required to sign a document indemnifying Bonsai Technologies against any claim, action, judgment, costs and/or expenses which may be made against Bonsai Technologies.
- ◇ Guests entering national parks and reserves will be required to sign a document indemnifying the national park and the nature reserve against any claim, action, judgment, costs and/or expenses which may be made against SAN Parks or the reserve.
